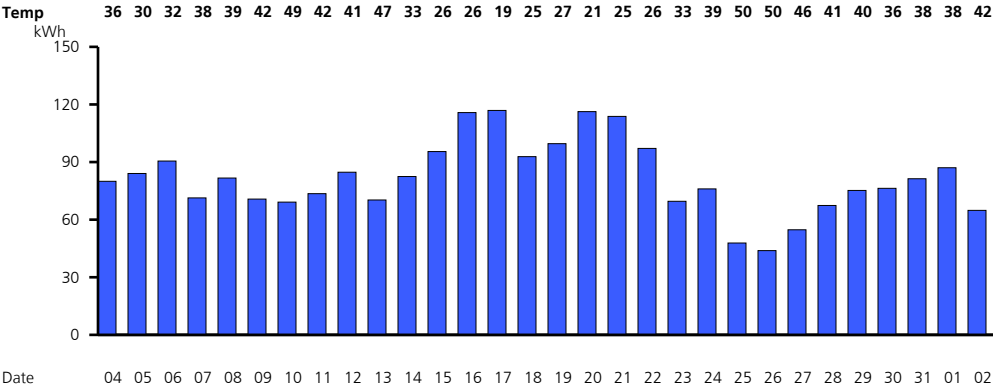

Effective January 10, 2024, for accounts billed under the Residential Heating service, the EDIT 6 year credit changed from (\$0.001763) to \$0.000000. For accounts billed under the General Service Space Heating service, the EDIT 5 year credit changed from (\$0.000541) to \$0.000000. For accounts billed under the Outdoor Lighting service, the EDIT 6 year credit changed from (\$0.35) to \$0.00.
